We also serve the community through various outreach activities such as Good Neighbor Checks, CPR classes, and the Vial of Life program.

This year, we are excited to announce that Wakefield Ambulance has upgraded our license to the Intermediate Advanced Life Support (IALS) level. This upgrade now allows our advanced providers to administer additional life-saving medications and therapies, such as epinephrine, dextrose, glucagon, CPAP, IV fluids, and 12-lead EKG's Wakefield is proud to be one of the first IALS units in the entire Commonwealth of Pennsylvania!

By subscribing as a member of the Wakefield Ambulance Association, you have the opportunity to support our volunteers and staff in a mission to provide the finest emergency medical care available. In addition, the benefits to you include:

Postmark by February 1, 2018 for full-year protection.)

- **DISCOUNT** on emergency medical care if uninsured or if insurance denies a claim
